Currently in Vermont, batterer intervention programs are intended for adult men who batter their female intimate partners. These programs are not intended for women, perpetrators of violence in same sex relationships, or for intervention in other forms of family violence such as child or elder abuse.

**Center for Crime Victim Services (800) 750-1213, TTY (800) 845-4874**

The Victims Compensation Program provides limited financial assistance to Vermont's victims of violent crime who have experienced a financial loss as a direct result of that crime, as long as that loss is not reimbursable through other sources, such as insurance. Although the crime must be reported to the police, eligibility is not dependent upon the arrest or conviction of the offender. Eligible expenses include, but are not limited to, crime-related expenses such as medical and dental care, mental health counseling, funeral costs, lost wages, and mileage. Other compensable expenses may include crime scene cleanup, rent/relocation, safety and security, travel and transportation, and childcare.

RISE features weekly recovery groups, individual therapy, and self-help meetings. All clients are expected to pay a modest weekly rent.
